## Q & A

Q1: Why do the cyclones seem to shy away from Mauritius in spite of global warming?

A1: In the absence of a detailed study of the region, several reasons could be invoked. With global warming, we would expect more favourable conditions for cyclones to form. But we see short-lived though intense cyclones in our region. The other favourable conditions for cyclone formation are not aligned. The sea in our vicinity is cooler.

Q2: When will the coastal area recover from the Wakasio oil spill of July 2020?

A2: It is expected that the coastal zones may recover over a period of 3 to 4 years, provide we continue to act responsibly and take good care of the zones.
